



**Meet the Rapid Developer:**  
Bridging IT and Business to Deliver Rock Star Results

Rapid development platforms, also called “no-code,” “high-productivity” or simply app platforms, have gained significant exposure in the past year. These platforms enable custom business applications to be built rapidly and deployed instantly without the need for traditional coding. Not only does the concept support speedy delivery, but it opens the door to a new type of developer, one less interested in coding and more interested in business results.

These business-savvy developers rely on visual modeling tools to easily define each element of an application (such as database, application and process logic, user interface, and security). In addition to visual development, platforms like Mendix offer a number of other features that further accelerate productivity, including an App Store with reusable templates, widgets and components, as well as social collaboration, enterprise integration and one-click deployment in the cloud.

With the rise of rapid development platforms, organizations are now able to slash project timelines from months to weeks (or even days). This time to market advantage is crucial for organizations struggling to keep pace with rising business demands, particularly as they look to innovate and differentiate themselves in competitive markets.

## Example 1:

# Savan Vyas, LV= Insurance

*Computer science graduate turned rapid developer to deliver better solutions.*

Savan Vyas, Scrum Master and Mendix Business Engineer at LV= is a great example of a rapid developer. Savan studied computer science at university and while he always liked application development—particularly the creative side of it—coding was something that he didn't particularly enjoy.

When he first came across the Mendix App Platform used at LV=, he says it was the “perfect” fit for him.

“You didn't have to learn 5-10 languages or worry about missing a comma somewhere. You could just focus on building apps that solve business problems.”

And solving business problems is exactly what Savan has done—quickly. In less than two years since joining the company, he's completed six app

delivery projects, including a broker workflow app and an app that allows distributors/brokers to use the company's platform to sell insurance policies.

Meanwhile, he says his developer friends at other companies are lucky to have finished one project in that same time.

# Javan Berry, Digital Risk

*Web designer turned rapid developer to provide greater value to the business.*

Javan Berry, Business Engineer at Digital Risk, a provider of risk, compliance and transaction management solutions, is another great example. Javan received his degree in web design and had been working as a front-end developer for more than a decade when he heard that Digital Risk was building a Mendix team. He immediately asked to be a part of it.

“I really hate coding and saw that Mendix would make it easier to build functionality,” he explains. “I was excited about the idea of doing everything on my own, and not needing a developer to finish my designs. I also saw this as a way for me to show greater value to the company.”

## Nolan Ramsey, EPI-USE America

*Business intelligence analyst turned to app building to solve new problems.*

Nolan Ramsey, Senior SAP Business Intelligence Consultant at EPI-USE America, provides yet another view on the unique skills behind the rapid developer title. Nolan originally received a business management degree before going back to school to study computer science.

Most recently, he has focused on business intelligence, specifically data warehousing, predictive modeling, and customer reporting. He discovered the power of Mendix at the request of one of his clients.

“It’s a completely new way to think about development. My BI background focuses on data retrieval and manipulation; I now need to think about data capture. Fortunately, the AGILE methodology framework made a lot of sense to me, specifically sitting with customers in real

time and working on frequent, rapid changes. BI is exactly the same, just from an analysis perspective.”

Nolan is in the process of building multiple new applications for his client. The largest, to date, includes a mobile expense management application. What started as a way to capture receipts online has grown into a full workflow management tool around receipts, from auditing workflows to integrating into SAP.
